## Nanoval and Ingpuls enter into strategic cooperation in the field of metal powder atomization

Establishment of a supply chain for high-purity metal powder made of NiTi SMA

Berlin and Bochum, 17. March 2025:

Nanoval GmbH and Ingpuls GmbH announce that they have entered into a strategic cooperation.

With the advancement in additive manufacturing technologies, the demand for high-quality NiTi powders is also continuously increasing. In order to be able to meet these sometimes very specific needs of customers for very different alloys, it is necessary that electrode production and metal atomization work hand in hand. A standard supplier relationship does not meet this requirement for various reasons, and especially in times of increasing demand.

Nanoval and Ingpuls have been working together intensively for several years and have continuously improved the joint processes for the production of metal powders from shape memory alloys during this time. Since then, customers from all over the world have been supplied with SMA powder. Together, the companies have now decided to intensify the cooperation in order to increase joint production capacities as well as reduce delivery times for customers.
